Family Shelter

- Sponsor a monthly birthday party for children residing at the Family Shelter (including games and snacks for about 60 people, birthday presents for the birthday children, and goodie bags for about 50 children).
- Plan a special activity such as craft night, game night, or holiday party.
- Participate in Operation Backpack during the months of June and July. (Backpacks filled with school supplies are collected for children served by Family Shelter, ReStart, and WCSD Children in Transition program).

Men's Shelter (Background check may be required)

- Help with cleaning activities between 8-11:00 a.m.

Women's Shelter Shelter (Background check may be required)

- Help with cleaning activities between 8-10:00 a.m.

ReStart Programs

- Clerical assistance including filing, Excel spreadsheets, and transcription (background check required).
- Accompany ReStart case manager on home visits (**Background check required**).

Resource Center

- Help staff the Resource Center front desk by greeting visitors, answering telephone calls, and sort mail (**Background check required**).

Collection Drive/Fundraiser

- Hold a fundraising event in support of our programs.
- Hold a collection drive to collect the following items for shelter residents:
 - Toiletries (i.e., deodorant, shampoo, dental hygiene, feminine hygiene, diapers, men's razors and shaving cream, toilet paper)
 - Blankets, gloves, hats and socks during the cold months
 - Used luggage or backpacks (suitcases, backpacks or duffel bags)
 - Crockpots or other household items for family "move out packages"
